## Heroes (Influential and Historical People) 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Book Report Due May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2019

During the fourth quarter, Fort Caspar Academy students will study influential historical people. Heroes will be the focus of the book report. The book report culminates in with an all-school "Hero" presentation in June.

Third graders will need to select a book about a historical figure that they feel has **hero qualities**. The book that the students select does not have to be within a certain lexile range, but should have sufficient information for a report. Each book must be approved by the child's teacher no later than April 16, 2019.

Third graders will be required to dress up like their hero. They are also required to bring at least one prop that represents their chosen hero. It is not necessary to spend a lot of money on the costume. Be creative! There are many ways to create a costume with items found in your home. Students must also prepare a 2-4 minute speech. Their speech should be given as the historical figure. Students may use notecards for the presentation. Use the attached rubric for the components to be included in the report. Try to find interesting information about your hero. The students will not hand in a written report. They are graded on the information in their speech. Please follow the rubric carefully.
